



Safety Guidelines

Please keep in mind that the fields you will be walking through are in their natural, agricultural condition. There are holes, tree stumps, rocks, mud, etc. Be vigilant and check the ground often as you walk.

Wagons regularly circle the fields. Stay 10 feet away from any moving tractors and wagons. Never run up to a moving tractor or wagon, and watch all children closely when any are in the vicinity.

Children need to be accompanied by an adult at all times.

Please only bring people- and animal-friendly pets with you during this outing. All pets must remain leashed for the entirety of the visit.

COVID-19 Safety Guidelines

If you are showing any of the following symptoms, please reschedule your visit for another day:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

Please take the following safety measures during your visit:

- Sanitize your hands regularly
- Wear a facial covering when on tractors, at common areas, or near other families in fields
- Maintain social distancing of at least six feet from members of other parties
- Cover any coughs and sneezes
